United Way

Ballad Health Foundation Patient Assistance

The Ballad Health Foundation Patient Assistance Fund helps oncology patients, outpatients and general inpatients who are experiencing financial distress outside of their medical bills. The fund exists for patients at any Ballad Health Cancer Care center, Ballad Health hospital or Ballad Health outpatient facility. Some examples of how the funds can be used: meal vouchers, transportation vouchers, clothing, prescription assistance, housing bills and more. Team members will be able to choose either oncology patient assistance, general patient assistance or outpatient assistance.

Niswonger Children's Hospital

Niswonger Children's Hospital serves more than 200,000 children and provides comprehensive care for infants, children and teenagers, including well-child care, immunizations, schools and sports physicals, as well as treatment for acute and chronic illnesses. It is home to one of only nine St. Jude Affiliate Clinics and comprehensive pediatric services, with access to more than 20 pediatric specialties due to its partnership with East Tennessee State University's Quillen College of Medicine's pediatric residency program and other pediatric specialty groups in this region. Niswonger Children's Hospital is also home to the Children's Resource Center, which aims to improve community health by investing in the health of children and their families through targeted outreach and support programs.
